#### Enriching the Learning experience:

### Inauguration of Computer Lab

Technology is central to development and progress. The 21<sup>st</sup> century being a Knowledge hub, technology opens up new opportunities for expanding the frontiers of knowledge and enriching the learning experience (digital learning). As part of one such transformational initiative, a **Computer Lab** was inaugurated on 24<sup>th</sup> January 2024 at the **Govt. P U College for Girls, Robertsonpet, KGF (Kolar dt.)**. A “dream project” of the CBJEF, this Computer Lab has been sponsored by **UTI AMC under its CSR initiatives**. The main objective is to train students, equip them with skills and enable them to access learning materials and resources online which could complement classroom instruction. This could also help in employment opportunities after P U education, as required. To begin with, 20 computers (PCs), UPS and suitable chairs (seating arrangement) have been provided for this purpose. The Computer Lab was inaugurated by the local MLA **Dr Roopakala M. Shashidhar** in the presence of Tahasildar – KGF and **Shri Siddhartha Dash**, Executive Vice-President, UTI AMC – Bangalore. The programme was attended by the leading lights of KGF as well as the office-bearers, governing body members and volunteers of CBJEF. The well set up Computer Lab also became possible because of the keen interest evinced by the college principal **Shri Munirathnam P.S.** and faculty **Dr. Kala Muthumari**.

## The Power of Print: CBJEF's Book Banks

Even as the world is increasingly absorbing, adopting and adapting to the digital world very fast, the Printed Word continues to stand out, with its relevance and usefulness – more so in remote places and rural areas. The physical book enables a reader to delve deep, providing easier accessibility to knowledge and learning, with several cognitive benefits as well. Towards this end, the CBJEF has continued establishing “Text Book Banks” (started in May 2019) in identified Govt. P U colleges. Aimed at providing Textbooks mainly to rural students in such places, the project has been very successful because of meticulous coordination and implementation by the CBJEF as well as responsive support from institutional donors – mainly **Canara Bank** (sponsor of CBJEF) and **UTI Asset Management Company Ltd.** (under its CSR activity). About 28000 notebooks have also been provided during the financial year 2023-24 to students of such colleges where Book Banks have been opened as well as over 350 merit scholarships to toppers studying in I & II PUC. Both the long notebooks to students and merit scholarships were sponsored by UTI AMC. Simultaneously, in the changing context, keeping in view the evolving needs, in order to further strengthen and extend the CBJEF's Book Bank facility, it was also thought of setting up the CBJEF's Book Bank (mainly by providing books from the CBJEF's library collection) in the premises of select colleges after mutual discussion and agreement.

**Book Bank at Govt. Engineering College:** On 7<sup>th</sup> December 2023, a simple function had been arranged at the **Sri Krishnarajendra Silver Jubilee Technological Institute**, K R Circle, Bangalore for the formal inauguration of the CBJEF's Book Bank in the premises of the college. The participants included **Dr M.B.Patil**, Principal of the college, HoDs and other faculty as well as students and invitees. On behalf of the CBJEF, **Shriyuths B.S.Ravishankar**, DGM, H R Wing, Canara Bank, H.O. & Hon.President – CBJEF; **N.S.Srinath**, Hon.Working President – CBJEF; **K.A.Bhat**, Hon.Vice-President – CBJEF and **D.S.Anandamurthy**, nominated member of the CBJEF's governing body, were present at the function. As part of its objectives, it has been disbursing token educational assistance to a few deserving, merit students hailing from indigent backgrounds. Under its “Pratibha Puraskara” programmes, meritorious rural High School students (SSLC) are honoured with token cash awards and certificates. Funding for all such programmes is largely met by a few donations and endowments created by philanthropists and well-wishers, including institutional donors. In the last few years, the CBJEF has been disbursing “Vidya Sahaya merit scholarships” to the top three scorers (of SSLC) studying in 1<sup>st</sup> year PUC and top three scorers (of 1<sup>st</sup> year PUC) studying in 2<sup>nd</sup> year PUC mainly in Govt. P U Colleges where CBJEF's “Text Book Banks” have been set up (Kolar, Hassan & Chikballapur districts, Govt. colleges in Bangalore).*
